The number of competitors per nation is determined according to the Rules of Audi FIS Alpine Ski World Cup 2011/2012 and FIS World Cup Quotas. Every competitor must own a national licence and must have signed the FIS athletes declaration (art. 203 ICR).

Entry to the race course is allowed only to the persons with the FIS season course accreditation and course accreditation issued by FIS Chief Race Director at the Team captains' meeting.

The access to the certain restricted zones of Competition area will be in accordance with official accreditations issued by the Organizer.




# GETTING THERE


